
Re: Fueling Aircraft from Tank Trucks

Dear Major Smith:

This letter is to inform you of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission's (TNRCC) decision on a question raised during one of our teleconferences last fall. The question was: "Are we required to count the emissions associated with fueling aircraft from tank trucks in determining whether we are a major site." The staff of the TNRCC has determined that you are not required to quantify these emissions in determining if your site is major.

We apologize for the delay in determining the answer to your question, but it took some time to coordinate the answer with the various divisions within the TNRCC.
