SUBJECT: Executive Order (EO) 13101, *Greening the Government Through Waste Prevention, Recycling and Federal Acquisition (14 Sep 98)*

I request your support to ensure your people are familiar with the requirements of EO 13101 and are taking appropriate actions to implement it in an efficient and cost effective manner. EO 13101 is available at: [www.ofee.gov](http://www.ofee.gov).

EO 13101 lays out procedures to establish the Federal Government as a leader in procurement of recycled and environmentally preferable products to conserve natural resources, reduce solid waste streams, and prevent pollution. Air Force policy supports these objectives. Success in attaining them requires leadership support for implementation of EO 13101 and teamwork among product-user, procurement, supply, and environmental organizations.

I was notified recently of the opportunity to procure many recycled and environmentally preferable products through the Javits-Wagner-O'Day (JWOD) Program. The JWOD Program generates employment for individuals who are blind or have other severe disabilities, and it operates supply centers at many installations (Atch). I encourage you to use your JWOD supply centers. Installation leaders should request their local JWOD supply center to stock EPA designated office supplies and other recycled and environmentally preferable products. For installations without a JWOD supply center, JWOD products are available on-line through GSA Advantage. In the near future, many items will be available through a JWOD Program e-commerce site.
